

# ActiveMarc Cymru has arrived!

## How can you showcase Dragon Sport in your school?

There are various things you can do now to make it easier if, or when, you decide to apply for ActiveMarc Cymru.

1. Have you got a Dragon Sport Portfolio? If not, speak to your DS Co-ordinator.
2. Keep all paperwork to do with your Dragon Sport clubs in your portfolio.  
**For example:** registers, copies of organiser training and coach ed. certificates, letters to parents, fair play agreements from festivals, photos of club, fixtures, festivals, entries for festivals, leaflets advertising sports clubs that have been sent through school, children's work
3. Keep registers for all your extra-curricular sports clubs (not just Dragon Sport clubs).
4. Return your Dragon Sport registers/figures as requested by your DS Co-ordinator on time by the end of every term.
5. Ensure every child attending extra-curricular sports clubs has a Dragon Sport passport. Keep them as a set in school. Bring the set to each club and make certain each child fills in their passport for every session they attend. Start a new passport each term. 6. Encourage at least 40% of girls and 40% of boys in key stage 2 to attend your Dragon Sport clubs.
7. Attend festivals and/or fixtures regularly.
8. Mention Dragon Sport in your school newsletters, governor's reports, etc.
9. Start a Dragon Sport notice board in your school.
10. Give out fair play awards on a monthly basis (look on the DS website for downloads of fair play certificates). Make a note of who has received the awards.
